Open reduction and internal fixation (ORIF) is surgery to repair a broken bone Open reduction means the doctor makes an incision (cut) to reach the bones and move them back into their normal position Internal fixation means metal screws, plates, sutures, or rods are placed on the bone to keep it

Open reduction internal fixation (ORIF) is usually complet-ed in two stages First, the broken bone is reduced, specifi-cally, a reduction by manipulation of the bone after surgi-cal exposure at the site of the fracture Second, an internal fixation device is placed on or in the bone Internal fixation

**PROXIMAL HUMERAL FRACTURE (ORIF)**

(OPEN REDUCTION / INTERNAL FIXATION) General Principles: 1 Bony healing occurs usually within 6 to 8 weeks in adults 2 Return to normal function and motion may require 3 to 4 months Overall Goals: 1 Increase ROM while protecting the fracture site (you can be slightly more aggressive with this vs a closed fracture due to the hardware
