Alpha Boxes After Reading Strategy

Effective vs Ineffective Strategies for “Reading to Learn” Before Reading Text: Proficient Readers Under-Prepared Readers Activate background knowledge on the subject through reflection and pre-reading Start reading without thinking about the subject or looking over the selection Establish a realistic reading plan after examining
